Linda celebrated her birthday with us recently.

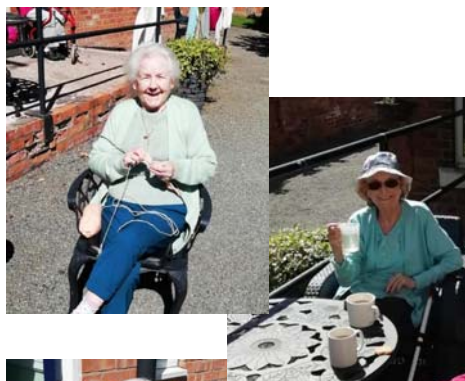


There were cards, gifts and a specially laid table for the birthday girl! We hope you had a great day, Linda.

As you can see, there was some crafting, chatting and definitely tea drinking!

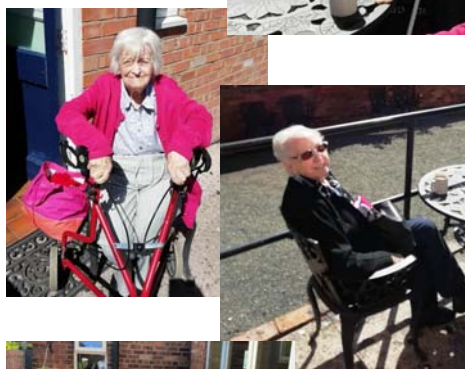


Respite Care
