We hope this newsletter finds you well and that you've been enjoying the wonderful weather we've had recently.

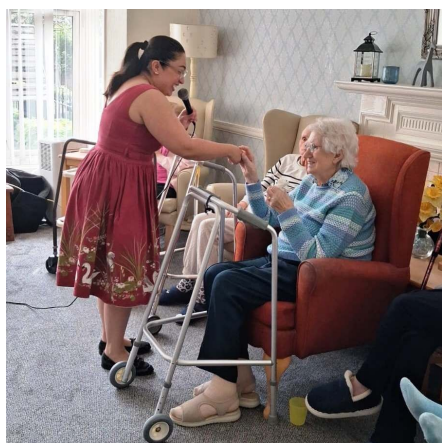
The past few weeks have been busy here with some new games and trips out to the lake as well as enjoying our regular activities and musical performers.
